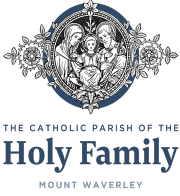

Dear Parishioners,

As we enter November, the Church invites us into a time of deep remembrance, starting with the Feast of All Saints which we celebrated last Friday and the Commemoration of All Souls the following day, Saturday November 2. On All Saints Day, we honour all holy men and women who, having lived lives of faith, are now united with God. This feast encourages us to aspire toward holiness, to be inspired by their examples of love and sacrifice, and to realise that sainthood is within reach for each of us.

November is also the month dedicated to praying for our dearly departed. As Christians, we believe in the Communion of Saints, where those on earth, in heaven, and in purgatory are united in a spiritual solidarity. Our prayers, especially during this month, are a powerful act of love that can bring peace and mercy to our loved ones who have passed away. As mentioned last weekend, Mass Offering envelopes will be available in the pews and foyer for anyone wishing to offer Masses for loved ones. A Memorial Book will also be placed near the altar, where you can write their names. Let us take time this month to remember them in our Masses, our rosaries, and our personal prayers.

This brings us to Pope Francis' latest encyclical, *Dilexit Nos* ("He Loved Us"). In his new encyclical, Pope Francis invites us to look deeply into the heart of Christ, where the fullness of God's love is revealed. This love isn't distant or abstract; rather, it reaches into our humanity, meeting us amid the complexities of daily life and the quiet longings within our hearts. For the laity, this message carries profound significance. While ordained ministry plays a unique and essential role within the Church's structure, *Dilexit Nos* reminds us that every baptized person is called to live out Christ's spirit of service. Baptism is our initiation into a vocation of love and service that extends well beyond the sanctuary. It calls us to bring Christ's love into our families, workplaces, communities, and all aspects of our lives. The heart of Christ serves as a model for a spirituality that belongs not only to the clergy but to every Christian, forming a path for all to live in His love.

Lastly, I'd like to share that Fr. Stephen will be away next week for a much-deserved retreat. Please keep him in your prayers as he takes time to reflect and recharge. We wish him peace, renewal, and God's abundant blessings.

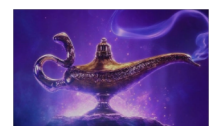
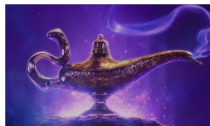
