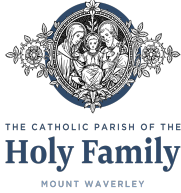

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for your well wishes and prayers during my recent bout of illness. As some of you may have heard, I have been grappling with the flu followed by a bout of food poisoning over the past few weeks. Regrettably, these health challenges necessitated the cancellation of several appointments. It was indeed a trying time, marked by high fever, chills, and all the usual symptoms that accompany such ailments. Visiting my GP, I was advised to replenish my fluids with *Hydralyte* due to dehydration caused by the loss of fluids. While my recovery is ongoing and my body still feels somewhat weakened, I am grateful to report that I am steadily improving.

I wish to express my sincere appreciation to those who attended our Parish Information evening for Jordanville parishioners last Wednesday evening. Despite the chill of the autumn night, we were blessed with a turnout of 36 individuals—a commendable number indeed. For those who were unable to join us due to prior commitments, fear not, as there will be ample opportunities for engagement in the near future. During the gathering, led by Mary Ryan and Michael Azzopardi from the Proclaim Team in the Archdiocese of Melbourne, participants were encouraged to connect with fellow parishioners, fostering new relationships and strengthening existing bonds. The discussions revolved around two pivotal questions: “What aspects of our parish do you hold dear and wish to preserve?” and “Given the chance, what changes or improvements would you propose?” Each table appointed a scribe to record their reflections, encouraging fruitful dialogue and exchange of ideas. It was heartening to witness the genuine enthusiasm and constructive feedback shared by all.

A recurring theme that emerged from our discussions was the warmth and hospitality at St. Mary Magdalen parish community—a sentiment with which I wholeheartedly resonate. While our community may be smaller in comparison to others, its tightly-knit nature nurtures a sense of belonging and camaraderie among its members. Furthermore, participants highlighted vital areas for growth, including evangelisation, the creation of a parish pastoral plan, and enhanced financial transparency. I am currently in the process of compiling the invaluable insights gathered and will discuss them at the next Parish Advisory Board meeting. I pledge to present a comprehensive report to the parish community at the earliest opportunity.

I also wish to express my gratitude to all who attended the ANZAC Day Masses at both of our parish communities last Thursday. The solemnity and reverence displayed during the services were truly moving, serving as a poignant reminder of the sacrifices made by those who have served our country. Let us continue to uphold them in our prayers and strive for peace in our world.

I extend my warmest regards to each one of you. May we continue to journey together in faith, guided by the light of Christ's love and compassion.
